MENDED HEARTS

In this class, we will make 2 "Mug Rugs" (large coasters). If you wish to make a larger project, the two blocks you make in class can be added to at home to make a placemat, table runner, or quilt by making more of the same blocks.

The pattern and batting will be provided in the class. Here's what you need to bring:

Fabric:

1 - 6-1/2" square block of a light color (I used white with a small pattern)

1 - 6-1/2" square block of a dark color (I used black with a small pattern)

2 - 6-1/2" square blocks for the back of the blocks. (I used a red/white check)

2 - 5" square blocks of complementary fabrics for the heart (one square of each color -I used 2 different reds)

1- fat quarter of (18" \times 22") of complementary fabric to make the binding - or the equivalent. (You can use the same light or dark that is in your block.)

Notions:

Rotary cutter (if you have one) and scissors

Straight pins

Sewing machine (there are 5 available in the sewing room) with straight stitch foot

and zig-zag foot (don't forget extra needles)

Several different color threads for the machine (the color of your fabrics)

Ruler for squaring up your blocks - $6" \times 12"$ works well.
