

## Travel Tissue Holder

### Supplies:

Fabric: 6" x 6-1/4"

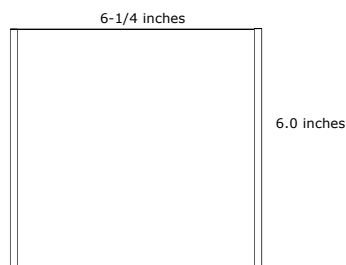
Bias Tape Binding 1-1/2 inches wide - 13" long

Or make your own contrasting binding (doesn't have to be on the bias)

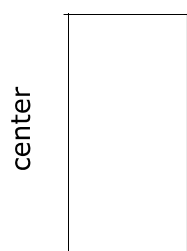
(Optional) Lace or rick-rack - 13" long

Tissue pack (works best if it opens down the middle)

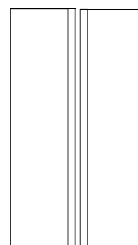
1. Sew lace and bias tape on the 6" edges



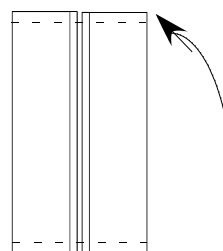
2. Locate center by folding in half and finger ironing to crease the center for marking



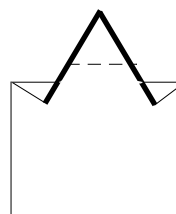
3. Fold bias bound edges into the center, right sides together



4. Sew top and bottom raw edges, using a 1/4" seam (zigzag or overcast edges)



4. Make each of the four corners "square" (use your finger to push out corner). Sew about 1/2 inch from tip, then cut tip off.



5. Turn inside out and insert tissue pack
