## LADDER YARN NECKLACE

(The club members have some available to be shared). The yarn does not appear to be available locally, but can be obtained from Amazon for \$3.00 per skein. Kathleen suggests members get together to order at the same time to reduce postage. A crochet hook, size E (some are available in the sewing room). 1 pony bead, to make the necklace adjustable. Some beads are available in the sewing room. All you need is a bead with a big enough hole for 10 strands of embroidery size yarn to go through. ## FABRIC WRAPPED COASTERS

These coasters are the best for your everyday use and also for gifts. If you missed **Kathy Moskovitz'** class two years ago, you won't want to miss this opportunity to learn a new technique for the sewing machine. Supplies for each coaster: (3)  $\frac{3}{4}$ " strips of batik fabric, 45" long. 8 feet of 3/16" cotton clothesline (cotton & polypropylene from Walmart is working). Matching thread. Sewing machine with zig-zag, open toe presser foot, and new sharp needle. Pins. Kathy will be teaching on Thursday, January 25, at 9:30 am.
