SPECIAL EVENTS

KNITTING 101 (three sessions)

Beginning January 8th **Marylu Belisle** will be teaching Knitting 101 - The goal is to learn or review the basics of knitting and to complete a hot pad. Discussion will include: supplies, casting on, knit and purl stitches, stitch appearance, and undoing stitches. Supplies: Knitting needles, yarn and a small crochet hook will be provided for members of Sewing Etc. participating in Knitting 101. (Up to 5 people.). Supplies YOU should bring to class: Scissors, large-eyed blunt tip needle, stitch markers, and point protectors. It's okay if you don't have them for the first session. Sometimes there are extras in the sewing room available to borrow; but, you will need your own supplies to continue with the lessons.

THREAD CATCHER BAG

Having one of these bags near your sewing area is a must. **Kathy Moskowitz** will teach this workshop on Thursday, Jan. 24 at 9:30 a.m. The supply list is as follows: 2 fat quarters will make one bag. Main fabric: 2- 6"x4" pieces (pincushion), 1- 4"x9.5" piece (strap), 1- 9.5"x 18" piece (bag). Coordinating fabric: 1- 9.5"x18" piece (bag lining)
