The next question is will the Woodchucks have sufficient access to be able to complete the cradles?

Stockings . . .

Wow! Fantastic work!

The bucket is nearly full.

Guess what?

We have more buckets! Yep! You can't fool this old broad! You make the stockings . . .

I will find another bucket!

So, keep up the great work on the stockings! There is no limit as to how many stockings we take to the base!!! All stockings will be put to good use there!

Also, remember, this is a perfect time to 'play' with your machine and to get your creative juices flowing. 'Strip' patterns . . . sew strips (A.K.A *scraps!*) at an angle down the length of the stocking, or across the width of the stocking.

Dial up those decorative stitches on your sewing machine.

Try the decorative stitches in different sizes and with different color threads.

Using 2 spools of thread - same color - thread them together and through the needle together and see what a difference it makes even with a 'regular' stitch, not just the decorative stitches.

It is amazing how much 'stronger' the stitch is!

Some of you have done decorative stitches on the hanging loop - good job!

Others did decorative stitches in the strip pattern - good job.

Have fun!
